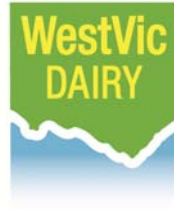

WESTVIC DAIRY SEEKS BOARD MEMBERS

Dairy farmers and industry representatives who want a say in how the local industry is developed are being encouraged to nominate for the Board of WestVic Dairy.

The Board is calling for nominations for three farmer representative vacancies and one industry position.

Nominations close on August 14 and the new Board members will be announced at WestVic Dairy's annual general meeting on August 30.

Current farmer representative members Matt Reid and Lisa Dwyer and industry representative Garry Smith have indicated they will renominate for their positions.

A vacancy will be filled after the resignation of farmer representative Graeme Martin.

The Board will also adopt recommended changes to its Statement of Purpose and Rules. The main changes cover the purpose of WestVic Dairy, categories of membership, operation of WestVic Dairy and forms of payment.

WestVic Dairy is the dairy industry development body for Western Victoria and is funded by Dairy Australia and the dairy service levy.

The Board is made up of six farmers and two independent members.

This year its AGM will be held at Glenormiston College from 12.15pm on August 30 during the lunch break of the Young Dairy Development Program's 'Milk It 4 More' Expo.

The 'Pathways For Your Future' expo and will focus on innovation and technology and is designed to inspire more people into the industry and to help them discover about the pathways they could take to progress in dairy.
